TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All landing nets must be dipped at time of purchasing tickets, and prior to fishing.
- Total surface fishing and zig rigs are banned (for the welfare of the fish). Float fishing - hooks are required to be 18" from the bottom of the float.
- Barbless hooks must be used.
- No movement of fish from lake to lake without permission of Milton Pools Fishery.
- You are reminded that you should be in possession of a current EA Licence(s).
- Unhooking mats must be used at all times (on ALL lakes).
- Two rods maximum.
- All anglers should have the courtesy and ask other anglers the position of their lines.
- Anybody found leaving their rods unattended in the water will be asked to leave the site and Milton Pools will take the responsibility of taking the rods out of the water.
- Minimum of 12lbs breaking strain must be used on the Specimen Lake.
- No bent hook or nailer type hook rigs or lead core line. No braided main lines.
- No use of braided lead, limpets or any such type of bottom line.
- No carp sacks, tubes or keepnets to be used.
- No fixed rigs, rigs should be made up so that should a carp be entangled in a tree, only a short leader will be left in its mouth when the line breaks.
- No barbed hooks, semi-barbed hooks or hooks with the barbs crushed down.
- All rods will be checked daily for barbed hooks and incorrect rigs, anybody found using these will be asked to leave.
- No nuts or particles, except hemp (shop bought only) and sweet corn.
- No bread
- Pike Fishing, no spinning or luring and dead bait only (not from other waters).
- No dogs allowed (except guide dogs).
- Failure to observe any of the above rules, or act in any way which interferes with others enjoyment or use of the lakes, will result in the offender being removed and banned permanently from the fishery, with NO REFUNDS GIVEN.
